



# CLEAN PARENTING

## A Brief Navigational Course in Smooth Sailing Parenting

**On this brief training, the participant will learn how the principles Clean Language develop a greater understanding and respect for personal experience that can increase deeply agreeable communication in families.**

**Participants will be introduced to the following concepts:**

- **Metaphors of meaning;** how to develop and identify personal constructs to help children and parents gain a greater personal understanding
- **Extending Narratives;** how to repair bridges when negative events or disagreements occur
- **How Do You Know When You Know and How Do you Know When You Don't Know;** helping your child to learn how they learn and navigate around "don't know" and blocks
- **Time and Space Signatures;** identifying the importance of personal time and space concepts to increase effective communication
- **Recycle, Reduce, Reuse, Redundant, Intergenerational Inheritance;** how past legacies of our family history can be used to navigate our collective family values in the present and the future

**Instructor:** Cei Davies Linn's partnership with David Grove, inventor of Clean Language, spanned three decades. Cei co-developed Clean Language work with David Grove over many years prior to David's untimely death. Together they worked evolving and developing the principles and conducting workshops, seminars and retreats which included the United States, New Zealand, Australia and the United Kingdom. The husband and wife team ran a retreat and seminar centre in Eldon, Missouri. Their collaboration also resulted in a number of training materials for professional counsellors. Cei has continued to evolve and develop the theory and practice of Clean Language with upcoming seminars and Personal Journey Experiential workshops in the UK, US and Japan. Previously Cei was a nursing sister and went on to hold the post of Senior Psychotherapist at St. Andrew's Hospital, Northampton. She currently lives in Northamptonshire and works clinically, writes, and lectures.
